\$8.00 Individual classes. Speech Group Classes \$12.00. (except Class 84).

Classes 84 & 107 \$16

Online registration fee (covers all sections) \$16 per individual competitor.

Age: Will be taken as at 25 June 2020. It is VERY important that you enter classes for your correct age as at the 25th June NOT at date of your section of the festival.

Online Speech Entries close with payment on receipt of entry by Monday 18th May.
No late entries accepted. Payment is by either online banking or via credit card. Credit Card is our preferred option. ***If you choose online banking please pay on entry.***

Time Limit: 3 minutes unless stated otherwise

Challenge Trophies: Competitors MUST COMPETE in all Classes specified.

Points: Please refer to Rule 19 in the General Conditions.

Video Recording: NO filming is to take place during the Speech & Drama Section. Also note that filming of judge's verbal comments is NOT allowed in any SAPACS section.

Prizes:

12 years and over - First \$12.00, Second \$10.00, Third \$8.00 unless otherwise stated. Note that Classes 100 to 104 (15 Years & Over), have special prize money of 1st \$20, 2nd \$15, 3rd \$10. Class 107 as advertised.

Any additional awards and donated prizes will be advised in the programme.

Performer's Extracts: Copies of Performer's Extracts (Class 107) must be sent to the Speech Convenor for forwarding to the Adjudicator at least two weeks before the opening date of the Festival. Failure to do so may result in disqualification. Competitors MUST COMPETE in at least two other Speech & Drama individual classes.

Also Note: A copy of pieces to be supplied to the Adjudicator on the day of the competition.

Programme: There is no charge for a printed programme on your entry form, as each section's timetable will be available, free of charge, as a pdf download at www.sapacs.org.nz.

Audience: The \$10 charge for one support person and venue hire (for that section) is automatically added to your entry form. Donations for additional entry at the Hawkins Theatre can be made at the door. No eftpos available.

For families who attend more than one art form, you may prefer to pre-order a “Friends” (whole festival) pass for \$20. This is issued at the door when you first attend a section.

Registration: SAPACS uses ONLY online registration for our festival. There is no downloadable or printed entry form available, as ALL entries MUST be done via the SAPACS website. Please contact lynda@sapacs.org.nz or phone 09 2385861 if you need assistance, however, please note that SAPACS is not able to do your online entries for you.

Teachers: please get your individual students to do their own entries. Your students will all get an invoice/summary of their classes entered for you to check. If for any reason teachers need to fill out the forms for their students, you **MUST NOT put your studio’s details in the competitor’s entry form boxes. All forms where the competitor and teacher contact details are the same, will not be entered into the system until manually checked.** These follow ups take up precious time. We MUST be able to personally contact every individual competitor entered.

Entries: The Executive reserves the right to cancel any class where insufficient numbers of entries are received. Classes may be divided where there are large numbers of entries.

Trophies: Please refer to Rule 16 in the General Conditions. All winners must sign for their Trophies before leaving the venue.

Conducted as group discussion with individual marks.
- CLASS 98 MIME. Created on a theme set by Adjudicator. Limit 2 mins.
30 seconds preparation.
- CLASS 105 SELECTION FROM SHAKESPEARE.
Extract from any play by Shakespeare.
Not costumed. Solo entries. Limit 4 mins. Title /Character on entry form.
- CLASS 106 SPEAKING OF NEW ZEALAND VERSE. Own Selection.
- CLASS 108 POETRY AND MUSIC. Spoken poetry accompanied by Competitor's own choice of music. Live or recorded. With an accompanist if preferred.
- CLASS 109 IMPROMPTU SPEECH. Topic to be selected by the Adjudicator.

Verse, Comments and Characterisation to be memorized. Other as preferred. A lectern will be available and simple properties may be used. **Competitor must enter and compete in at least two other Speech & Drama Classes. Entry Fee \$16.**
