PLEASE NOTE: TAP entries will be <u>strictly</u> limited. These entries will be accepted on a 'first in' basis, so you are encouraged to enter online as soon as you can. Enquiries as above.

Duos & Trios: Competitors may appear twice only in any Duo or Trio class, but only once with the same partners. All competitors' names must be on the entry form. It is NOT sufficient to say "partner".

Points: Refer to Rule 19 in the General Conditions.

Entries: The Executive reserves the right to cancel any class where insufficient numbers of entries are received. Classes may be divided where there are large numbers of entries.

Trophies: Please refer to Rule 16 in the General Conditions. All winners must sign for their Trophies before leaving the Theatre.

Tap Championship: Conditions to be eligible for Tap Championships -

Competitors must have won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd placing in a Tap Championship or Tap Age Group. Competitors who have been placed in a Restricted Class only are not eligible. Competitors must also compete in the Tap Class for their age group.

Time Limit: Maximum time limit of three (3) minutes, unless otherwise stated

<u>Payment</u>: Is by either online banking or via credit card. Credit Card is our preferred option because it saves us chasing up unpaid entries. If paying online please ensure that entry fees are paid by the due date shown below to avoid us having to follow up for payment!

<u>Audience</u>: The \$10 charge for one support person and venue hire (for that section) is automatically added to your entry form. Donations for additional entry at the Hawkins Theatre can be made at the door.

At Pukekohe venues the charges for additional audience members are \$5 per session, \$8 for two sessions and \$10 for 3 sessions for adults. (Students/Seniors: \$2, \$3, \$5). No eftpos available.

For families who attend more than one art form, you may prefer to pre-order a "Friends" (whole festival) pass for \$20. This is issued at the door when you first attend a section.

Online Tap Entries at standard rate close: 20th May at 10pm.

Late entries will be accepted online until 10pm on 2nd June (Tuesday following Queen's Birthday Monday). The late fee payment of \$2 extra per class will automatically be added to your entry form from 10pm, 20th May. <u>ALL TAP ENTRIES MUST BE PAID</u> FOR BY 11th JUNE to be included in the programme.

<u>Programme</u>: There is no charge for a printed programme on your entry form, as each section's timetable will be available, free of charge, as a pdf download at <u>www.sapacs.org.nz</u>.

<u>Registration</u>: SAPACS uses ONLY online registration for our festival. There is no downloadable or printed entry form available, as ALL entries MUST be done via the SAPACS website. The link should be available by late February/early March for all competitions. Note that the festival has TWO cut-off entry dates due to the spread of competition dates. Please contact <u>lynda@sapacs.org.nz</u> or phone 09 2385861 if you need assistance, however, please note that SAPACS is not able to do your online entries for you.

<u>Teachers</u>: please get your individual students to do their own entries. Your students will all get an invoice/summary of their classes entered for you to check. If for any reason teachers need to fill out the forms for their students, you **MUST NOT put your studio's details in the competitor's entry form boxes.** All forms where the competitor and teacher contact details are the same, will not be entered into the system until manually checked. These follow ups take up precious time. We MUST be able to personally contact every individual competitor entered.

Safety/Security: The stage door at Hawkins Theatre, which opens onto a narrow access driveway, is NOT to be used as a "first point of entry". ALL performers, parents, siblings, teachers etc MUST report to the front desk. Please ask the competitors NOT to give access via the stage door unless cleared to do so by SAPACS personnel on stage duty.

Sound System: The Hawkins Theatre Sound System will be used for the dancing Section. Competitors must have CD's named and in good playing order. Note: Scratched or re-recordable CD's may not play on the Hawkins Theatre system.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE

Please only enter the Nomination class if you are seeking a Nomination **AND** are committed to attending and competing at the National Young Performer Awards in Palmerston North 16-18 Oct 2020. AT SAPACS: Entry fees are not refundable. The prize money is to assist with your travel expenses. If you choose NOT to represent SAPACS at the national final, you may be asked to refund a portion of your prize money – depending on the circumstances of your withdrawal. Please note that if you have accepted a Nomination by another Society for this year's Young Performer Award (for this item), you may NOT compete at SAPACS in the Nomination Award class. This is a PACANZ rule. Please advise us if you are withdrawing from the Nomination Award for any reason.

- 1. Performers will be 15 and under 21 years as at 1st of October 2020.
- 2. Each performer at Nationals will compete in three classes during the preliminary rounds. Two classes at SAPACS.
 - 1. Championship 3 Speed
 - 2. Tap Dance, own selection (not Song and Dance).
 - 3. Nationals: All performers will participate in a Master Class, taken in the manner of an Audition, conducted by or for the Adjudicators. No audience observation will be permitted. The Master Class will be taken into consideration in determining the semi-finalists.
- 3. There shall be a maximum time limit of 4 minutes for each dance, taken from the beginning to the conclusion of the music. A penalty of 5 marks will be imposed if the time limit is exceeded by 10 seconds.
- 4. Nationals: There will be a semi-final of up to twelve performers who will repeat either B1 or B2, at the discretion of the adjudicators. The number of semi-finalists is determined as per the NYPA rules 7.1-7.2. Competitors will be chosen based on their marks in the Preliminary round(s).
- 5. Nationals: For the Final Award Concert six performers will be recalled, and shall repeat the item not performed at the semi-final.

SOCIETY NOMINATION

Each Society, which is a financial member of PACANZ, **may nominate up to two competitors,** who shall be selected by the adjudicator, based on a performance as outlined in A-D. The adjudicator will determine that a competitor has displayed a sufficient standard of performance to competently represent that society at the National Finals. The standard required will be at the absolute discretion of the adjudicator but will include:

A demonstration of adequate preparation, An authority of performance, A performance with a level of maturity commensurate with a national final competition of this age group.

If the adjudicator considers that sufficient standard has **NOT** been reached by any competitor, then **NO** nomination will be made.

The Nominating Society is responsible for paying part of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards i.e. **\$75 inc gst per Nominee**

Each Nominee is responsible for paying the rest of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards i.e. **\$175.00 incl gst**
