Welcome to the 57th annual SAPACS Festival! If this will be your first Festival with us, then we are especially looking forward to hearing you sing. We would ask that you take careful note of the following "Competition Protocols" and "General Rules".

Age: Has been taken as at 25 June 2021.

Time Limit: 4 minutes unless stated otherwise. Operatic and Oratorio Classes must not exceed 8 minutes.

Challenge Trophies & Points: Competitors MUST COMPETE in all Classes specified. Please refer to Rules 16 & 19 online. Winners generally sign for their trophies.

Recording:

Generally, a competitor may arrange for his or her performance to be recorded by an audience member. You are reminded that IN NO CIRCUMSTANCES may you record, on any device, another performer without their permission. Flash photography is not allowed DURING an item. Please use tripods with consideration for the audience and note that the adjudicator's view must not be obscured. Adjudicator's comments are not to be recorded at any SAPACS festival.

Prizes:

11 Years & Under and Restricted - Medals First, Second and Third

12 years and over - First \$12.00, Second \$10.00, Third \$8.00 unless otherwise stated.

16 & 17 Years Championship Classes have special prize money of:

1st \$25, 2nd \$15, 3rd \$10.

Recital & Duet prize money as shown in the syllabus.

Adult prizes as advertised for each class.

Audience: The \$10 charge for one support person and venue hire (for that section) is automatically added to your entry form. Donations/Koha for additional entry at the Hawkins Theatre can be made at the door. **No eftpos available.** For families who attend more than one art form, you may prefer to pre-order a "Friends" (whole festival) pass for \$20. This is issued at the door when you first attend a section.

Entries: Ensure that you do **NOT** perform the same piece in more than one class or have entered a piece that has won you a first prize at **THIS** competition in the past 3 years.

Printed Music/Points Penalties:

A good quality photocopy (or original) **MUST** be provided for the Adjudicator. The top right hand corner is to show Competitor's name, Class Number and Number in that Class.

There will be a penalty of 3 points applied for a change of title once the Programme has been placed online. The same penalty will be applied for exceeding the stated time limit by more than ten seconds at the festival. The deduction will be shown clearly on all Report Sheets e.g. 82 - 3 = 79. Please also note that the bell will be rung if the item is excessively long.

Please ensure that you own or have access to original published/legal editions for all songs performed. It is up to teachers/competitors to prove ownership if requested. It is not essential to bring original music to the festival. Any music used by singers (e.g. Oratorio / Choir music) **MUST** be a published/legal edition.

Accompanying:

Please note that we have a change of official accompanist for the junior section: It will now be Bronwyn Spencer, who is based near Pukekohe. Junior competitors (who wish to) can rehearse with Bronwyn at Pukekohe. Please book this soon by emailing bronwynhughes@gmail.com. Junior fee is \$12 per song (to be paid at or before the

rehearsal) and it covers one short run-through and accompanying at the festival itself. If you require further rehearsal time, please negotiate this yourself.

Kay Shacklock is still available to play for the adult classes. Please contact Kay yourself in plenty of time to arrange your rehearsal and negotiate a fee directly with her. Kay Shacklock (09) 535 3283, 021 0503896 - kay@shacklock.net.nz. Texts only during the festival please for Kay.

Duet and Group Classes:

Ribbons will be awarded to each member of a vocal group who is placed. A competitor may *perform twice in a duet class provided it is with a different partner each time.*

Choirs/Vocal Groups please note: Marks will not be lost for using printed music, but extra marks may be awarded for overall presentation.

If entering more than one Vocal group in a Class, please note:

Each individual member of a vocal group may appear only **TWICE** in any one Class.

Each vocal group within a Class must not have more than HALF the same individual members.

Accompaniment for Vocal Section:

Solos/Duets may be accompanied by one instrument in addition to, or instead of, a piano.

Small groups may be accompanied by up to two additional instruments (and/or piano).

Choirs (over 8 singers) may use up to four additional instruments (and/or piano).

Backing Tracks MAY be used for Popular/Light Entertainment solo, duet and group items in appropriate classes. They must NOT include ANY vocals. Backing Tracks should **not** be used in Own Selection classes, Folk Song Classes or the Recital classes. **PLEASE GIVE ADVANCE NOTICE THAT YOU WILL BE USING BACKING TRACKS. THEY WILL NEED TO BE EMAILED IN TO OUR TECHNICIAN.**

Junior Section Regional Awards for outstanding performance by a local singer.

\$50 Senior Award with miniature. \$25 Junior Award with miniature.

The adjudicator will have a list of those competitors who are resident in: The former Franklin, Papakura & Manurewa Districts, Ardmore/Clevedon (including wider rural area) but excluding all other areas of the former Manukau City. **PLEASE ALSO SEE FURTHER INFORMATION AT THE END OF THE PROGRAMME about CVMFT awards.**

Vocal Section Tuition Grants:

There are two tuition grants available for the Adult Vocal Section and we thank Delia and Phil Cook and Stockman General Contractors Ltd for their support of these. These grants are awarded to a person aged between 18 and 25 years who is in full time study at a recognized tertiary institution or who is receiving private music tuition. The grants are awarded to the competitor with the highest mark in each class (below) who meets this criteria. This may, therefore, not necessarily be the winner. These grants are in addition to the prize money listed.

(1) \$300 Adult Recital Class 1 and \$200 for Oratorio Solo Class 3. (P & D Cook)

(2) \$300 for the Operatic Solo - Class 2. (Stockman General Contractors)

Folk / Traditional Song – Generally music/text will be handed down by oral tradition. This may be arranged, and it is permissible to use text with a known author that has been set to a traditional melody.

Own Selection Classes – Not an action song (gesture only). No costume.

Restricted – Open to competitors who have not received a First Placing for solo voice in THIS FESTIVAL or ANY OTHER Performing Arts Competition at the time of entry.

This is not restricted to a particular age, but the minimum age will be 18yrs old. The award will be for the most promising performer who has competed and placed in the Oratorio and Sacred Solo section (Class 3) and shown promise and commitment in other classes.

The Lindsay & Fred Hellaby Junior Vocal Scholarship

A \$300 scholarship to be awarded to a resident from the South Auckland area* who shows significant potential in singing. This is not aimed at a particular age, but the maximum age will be 17yrs old. The award will be for the most promising performer aged 17 or below who has competed and placed at least 2 classes, and has preferably presented a sacred solo in any class, and shown promise and commitment in other classes.

This is not restricted to a particular age, but the minimum age will be 13yrs old. Preference is for a violoncellist in keeping with the wishes expressed by the donor family. Mr Williams had a particular love of this instrument. If there is no suitable candidate in this category, it may be awarded to any instrumentalist. This will be decided by the Adjudicator in consultation with a member of the CVMFT board or its nominee. Further preference will be given to a student who has expressed and exhibited a serious intention to pursue music as a career pathway.

The Lindsay & Fred Hellaby Junior Instrumental Scholarship

A \$300 scholarship to be awarded to a resident from the South Auckland area* who shows significant potential in their chosen discipline. This is not aimed at a particular age, but the maximum age will be 12yrs old. The award will be for the most promising performer aged 12 or below who has competed and placed at least 2 classes, and shown promise and commitment in other classes.

The recipients are expected to perform as special guest artists at the CVMFT Sunday Serenades at St Andrew's "Young Rising Talent" concert in November of the year of the Award. In the case of 2021, the date is November 7th at 1.30pm, with a rehearsal on Nov 6th. If this is not possible, an alternative concert will be chosen.

The above awards will be decided by the Adjudicator in consultation with a member of the CVMFT board or its nominee. Preference will be given to a student who has expressed and exhibited a clear intention to pursue music as a serious pathway. If the adjudicator and the CVMFT advisor believe there is no suitable candidate for any particular award, that award will be withheld.

*Defined as residing in one of the current three wards of Franklin, Manukau and Manurewa-Papakura of Auckland Council, or in the previously defined Franklin district.

The Lindsay & Fred Hellaby Junior Performing Artist Scholarship

A \$300 scholarship to be awarded to a resident from the South Auckland area* who shows significant potential across more than one chosen discipline or section. This is not aimed at a particular age, but the maximum age will be 17yrs old. The award will be for the most promising performer aged 17 or below who has competed and placed at least 2 different sections (Vocal, Instrumental, Speech and Drama, Piano, and any Dance Section), and shown promise and commitment in these areas.

The recipient is expected to perform as a special guest artist at the CVMFT Sunday Serenades at St Andrew's "Young Rising Talent" concert in November of the year of the Award. In the case of 2021, the date is November 7th at 1.30pm, with a rehearsal on Nov 6th. If this is not possible, an alternative concert will be chosen.

The award will be decided by the Adjudicators in consultation with a member of the CVMFT board or its nominee. Preference will be given to a student who has expressed and exhibited a serious intention to pursue performing arts as a career pathway. If the adjudicator and the CVMFT advisor believe there is no suitable candidate for any particular award, that award will be withheld.

*Defined as residing in one of the current three wards of Franklin, Manukau and Manurewa-Papakura of Auckland Council, or in the previously defined Franklin district.

FURTHER OPTIONS :

Eligible candidates are invited to consider the following. These are not restricted to SAPACS contestants.

The CVMFT South Auckland Tuition Scholarships (Study Grants – through the Lindsay & Fred Hellaby Sponsorship Programme)

Criteria:

1. Must reside in one of the current three wards of Franklin, Manukau and Manurewa-Papakura of Auckland Council.
2. Requires evidence of financial hardship or need.

3. Will be paid to the teacher of that student on a quarterly basis, dependent on a satisfactory report from the teacher.
4. Must perform in a CVMFT concert and at a St Andrew's 9.15am service (or other special event) during the year of tenure.
5. All ages will be considered, with particular preference to those who have demonstrated both a significant talent for and clear dedication of their discipline.
6. A suitable reference (written or verbal) from a qualified person well-acquainted with the applicant's track record and abilities is required. Contact details of this person to be provided.
7. Applications in writing to the Chair and Board open in January of each year and remain open until the Scholarship is awarded.

Singular Individual Grants

These may be disbursed from time-to-time as funds allow, and are based on significant and urgent need. Applicants must demonstrate clear hardship or shortfall for a specific project, and provide evidence of ability and long-term commitment. Applications may be made 3 times a year in February, July and November.
