Welcome to the 57th annual SAPACS Festival! If this will be your first Festival with us, then we are especially looking forward to hearing you play. We would ask that you take careful note of the following "Competition Protocols" and "General Rules".

Entry Fees:

\$8.00 Individual classes. Duets, Recitals \$12.
Online registration fee (covers all sections) \$16 per individual competitor.

<u>Age</u>: Will be taken as at 25 June 2021. It is VERY important that you enter classes for your correct age as at the 25th June NOT at date of your section of the festival.

<u>Time Limit:</u> Each class has a time limit shown in both the syllabus and programme. All items are timed and these are strictly enforced. (see penalty note below). Note that the bell may be rung if the item is excessively long. You may musically edit a longer piece to fit our time limits without any penalty.

<u>Challenge Trophies & Points</u>: Competitors MUST COMPETE in all Classes specified. Winners generally sign for their trophies.

Recording:

Generally, a competitor may arrange for his or her performance to be recorded by an audience member. You are reminded that IN NO CIRCUMSTANCES may you record, on any device, another performer without their permission. Flash photography is not allowed DURING an item. Please use tripods with consideration for the audience and note that the adjudicator's view must not be obscured. Adjudicator's comments may not be recorded in any section at SAPACS.

Prizes:

- 11 Years & Under and Restricted Medals First, Second and Third
- 12 Years & Under Non-Championship Classes Medals
- 13 Years and Over -1st \$12.00, 2nd \$10.00, 3rd \$8.00 unless otherwise stated.
- 16 Years & Over Championship Classes 144, 145 & 146 have special prize money of: 1st \$25, 2nd \$15, 3rd \$10.

Recital & Duet prize money \$25, \$15, \$10. Four Hands duet \$40 1st prize. Second prize \$20. Any additional awards and donated prizes will be advised in the programme.

<u>Entries</u>: The Executive reserves the right to combine or cancel any classes where insufficient numbers of entries are received. Classes may be divided where there are large numbers of entries. Please note that each section of the festival has a maximum number of items that will fit in the allocated days. Once this number has been reached, you may find that the online entry form has been taken down.

Online Entries at standard rate close:

Friday 7th May at 10pm or until the festival is full. If the form is still online, then there is still space. Late entries may be accepted online until 10pm on 21st May, depending on space. The late fee payment of \$2 extra per class will automatically be added to your entry form from 10pm, 7th May.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PAID FOR AS SOON AS YOUR INVOICE IS EMAILED TO YOU to be included in the programme. *PLEASE NOTE THIS NEW RULE.* Please pay by internet banking to 12-3031-0793879-00 or by a credit card. In the particulars, use your **reference number** and the **participant's name**. PLEASE DECIDE ON PAYMENT METHOD **BEFORE** ENTERING, AS YOU CAN'T ACCESS YOUR FORM ONCE SUBMITTED and we don't want to have two forms with conflicting payment information.

<u>Programme</u>: There is no charge for a printed programme on your entry form, as each section's timetable will be available, free of charge, as a pdf download at www.sapacs.org.nz.

<u>Audience</u>: The \$10 charge for one support person and venue hire (for that section) is automatically added to your entry form. Donations for additional entry at the Hawkins Theatre can be made at the door. At Pukekohe venues the charges for additional audience members are \$5 per session, \$8 for two sessions and \$10 for 3 sessions for adults. (Students/Seniors: \$2, \$3, \$5). No eftpos available.

For families who attend more than one art form, you may prefer to pre-order a "Friends" (whole festival) pass for \$20. This is issued at the door when you first attend a section.

Registration: SAPACS uses ONLY online registration for our festival. There is no downloadable or printed entry form available, as ALL entries MUST be done via the SAPACS website. The link should be available by late February/early March. Please contact lynda@sapacs.org.nz or phone 09 2385861 if you need assistance, however, please note that SAPACS is not able to do your online entries for you.

<u>Teachers</u>: please get your individual students to do their own entries. Your students will all get an invoice/summary of their classes entered for you to check. If for any reason teachers need to fill out the forms for their students, you **MUST NOT put your studio's details in the competitor's entry form boxes. All forms where the competitor and teacher contact details are the same, will not be entered into the system until manually checked. These follow ups take up precious time. We MUST be able to personally contact every individual competitor entered.**

Please **enter ALL titles and composers SPELT CORRECTLY**. Ensure that you do **NOT** enter the same piece in more than one class or enter a piece that has won you a first prize at **THIS** competition in the past 3 years. You cannot enter a piece in the restricted class and then perform it again in another class.

<u>Missing or Changing Information</u>: Please contact Lynda if you need to change or add any information about your performances once entered. **DO NOT ENTER AGAIN**. You will be permitted to make changes until the programme is published online. (see below for further details about this).

Printed Music/Points Penalties:

A good quality photocopy (or original) **MUST** be provided for the Adjudicator. The top right hand corner is to show Competitor's name, Class and Number in that Class. An indication of timing would also be appreciated.

There will be a penalty of 3 points applied for a change of title once the Programme has been placed online. The same penalty will be applied for exceeding the stated time limit by more than ten seconds at the festival. The deduction will be shown clearly on all Report Sheets e.g. 82 - 3 = 79.

Competitors are reminded that they **MUST** use a published or legally downloaded copy of the music when performing, to comply with copyright laws. A disqualification will apply if you play from photocopied music. If playing from memory, your original copy must be available for inspection if asked for. A good quality photocopy (or original) **MUST** be provided for the Adjudicator.

NO PHOTOCOPIER WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE VENUE. PLEASE BRING YOUR JUDGE'S COPY WITH YOU. Own composition: 127 & 137 - A copy MUST be provided for the adjudicator. Please Note: There will be no practice permitted on the piano before the Festival performance.

Duet Classes:

Duet classes are to be entered in age group of older/oldest competitor. A competitor may enter a duet class twice provided it is with a different partner each time. Please ensure that we have his/her correct date of birth and name spelt correctly on entry form. Entry fees cannot be split across the competitors in a duet class. The online system will give each competitor the opportunity to register/name their partner. Please decide prior to entering the festival which performer will do the entry. Duets must be played ON ONE PIANO except for the special class "8 hands" being offered again this year.

Definitions of Classes:

Baroque:

For a 'Baroque' class, the work presented **must** have been composed in the Baroque era. Suggested composers could be J S Bach, Handel or D Scarlatti **but** this class is **NOT** restricted to those composers.

Romantic or Impressionist:

A work from the time of John Field and Schubert through to the early 20th Century.

20th Century to Present Day: The music in these classes should be post-romantic in style and by a composer who was alive in 1930 or up to the present day.
