BALLET Adjudicator: MONIQUE POIRIER

Welcome to the 58th annual SAPACS Festival! If this will be your first Festival with us, then we are especially looking forward to seeing you perform. We would ask that you take careful note of the following "Competition Protocols" and "General Rules".

Age: Has been taken as at 25 June 2022.

Class Information:

- Classes may have been divided by age if there were a large number of entries.
- Classes may have been combined or cancelled if there were insufficient entries.
- You **MUST COMPETE in ALL classes** listed for age-group championships ("Most points cups") to be eligible for the award.
- **Restricted Classes** are open to competitors who have **NOT WON A FIRST PLACING AT THESE OR ANY SIMILAR COMPETITIONS AT ANY AGE.**

Music: Please upload music to the WE Developments glide app. More information will be emailed to all competitors

PRIZES

Under 12 years and Restricted - Medals First, Second and Third 12 years and over - First \$12.00, Second \$10.00, Third \$8.00

Note that Classes 200 to 204, 14 Years & Over classes, have special prize money of \$25, \$15, \$10.

Any additional awards and donated prizes will be advised in the programme.

Recording Items: Generally, a competitor may arrange for his/her performance to be recorded by an audience member. **IN NO CIRCUMSTANCES** may you record, on any device, another performer without their permission. Flash photography is not allowed DURING an item. Please use tripods with consideration for the audience and note that the adjudicator's view must not be obscured. **PLEASE DO NOT SIT IN FRONT OF THE ADJUDICATOR WHILE FILMING.** Adjudicator's comments are **NOT** to be recorded.

Definitions of Classes:

- DEMI CHARACTER - in the Ballet Section this should not be confused with Musical Theatre, which lets the song tell the story. Ballet Demi Characters should rely on movement, expression and mime to tell the story with ballet based steps.
- CHARACTER - is a National dance and needs to consist of traditional steps from the chosen country.
- BAREFOOT - the music, movement and costume should all be symbolic and carry out the concept/theme.

10. Performance and Audience Protocols

Mobile phones, watch alarms and other noise-emitting electronic devices must be SWITCHED OFF on total silent mode (i.e. no vibrating alert). All competitors and

audience are respectfully reminded that it is unsettling and distracting to have movement in the auditorium/room during an item. PLEASE do not attempt to leave or enter until a competitor has finished performing. Check the door does not slam/bang behind you.

Every care has been taken with the processing of entries, sponsorship, requests for changes etc, but errors may have occurred. Please advise Rachel (email above) immediately of anything that needs to be added or amended.

BALLET CHAMPIONSHIP - *The following dancers are eligible for the stated championship classes or local awards. See rules 15 and 19 of competition rules*

15. CHAMPIONSHIPS – Most championships in this festival are decided on points awarded for places gained in constituent events. Where this is applicable, please note that TO QUALIFY, A COMPETITOR MUST COMPETE IN ALL CLASSES SPECIFIED

19. POINTS – For challenge trophies, points awarded shall be: First Place – Five, Second Place – Three, Third Place – One. In the event of a tie on points, award to be decided on aggregate marks. Rule 20 will be actioned. In the event of a tie in placings in a class, points will be awarded as follows: Four points each for First equal, One point to next placed competitor. Two points each for Second equal and no Third. Half a point each for Third equal. In the event of a tie in placings in a class, placings will be awarded as follows: First equal – No Second, but there will be a Third. Second equal – No Third. Third equal – No Very Highly Commended.
