*Welcome to the 59th annual SAPACS Festival! If this will be your first Festival with us, then we are especially looking forward to hearing you sing. We would ask that you take careful note of the following "Competition Protocols" and "General Rules".*

**Age:** Has been taken as at 25 June 2023. Note that competitors under the age of 5 years on the 25<sup>th</sup> June in the year of competition are not eligible to take part in any of the music sections.

**Time Limit:** 4 minutes unless stated otherwise. Operatic and Oratorio Classes must not exceed 8 minutes.

**Challenge Trophies & Points:** Competitors MUST COMPETE in all Classes specified. Please refer to Rules 16 & 19 online. Winners generally sign for their trophies.

### **Recording:**

Generally, a competitor may arrange for his or her performance to be recorded by an audience member. You are reminded that IN NO CIRCUMSTANCES may you record, on any device, another performer without their permission. Flash photography is not allowed DURING an item. Please use tripods with consideration for the audience and note that the adjudicator's view must not be obscured. Adjudicator's comments are not to be recorded at any SAPACS festival.

### **Prizes:**

11 Years & Under and Restricted - Medals First, Second and Third

12 years and over - First \$12.00, Second \$10.00, Third \$8.00 unless otherwise stated.

16 & 17 Years Championship Classes have special prize money of:

1<sup>st</sup> \$25, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$15, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$10.

Recital & Duet prize money as shown in the syllabus.

Adult prizes as advertised for each class.

**Audience:** The \$10 charge for venue hire and ancilliary expenses (for that section) is automatically added to your entry form. Donations (koha) for additional entry at the

**Hawkins Theatre can be made at the door. No eftpos available.** For families who attend more than one art form, you may prefer to pre-order a "Friends" (whole festival) pass for \$20. This is issued at the door when you first attend a section.

**Entries:** Ensure that you do **NOT** perform the same piece in more than one class or have entered a piece that has won you a first prize at **THIS** competition in the past 3 years.

**Printed Music/Points Penalties:**

A good quality photocopy (or original) **MUST** be provided for the Adjudicator. The top right hand corner is to show Competitor's name, Class Number and Number in that Class.

There will be a penalty of 3 points applied for a change of title once the Programme has been placed online. The same penalty will be applied for exceeding the stated time limit by more than ten seconds at the festival. The deduction will be shown clearly on all Report Sheets e.g. 82 - 3 = 79. Please also note that the bell will be rung if the item is excessively long.

Please ensure that you own or have access to original published/legal editions for all songs performed. It is up to teachers/competitors to prove ownership if requested. It is not essential to bring original music to the festival. Any music used by singers (e.g. Oratorio / Choir music) **MUST** be a published/legal edition.

**Accompanying:**

Please note that currently there is no official accompanist for the Vocal Section. Please contact us if you need help.

**Duet and Group Classes:**

Ribbons will be awarded to each member of a vocal group who is placed. A competitor may *perform twice in a duet class provided it is with a different partner each time.*

**Choirs/Vocal Groups please note:** Marks will not be lost for using printed music, but extra marks may be awarded for overall presentation.

**If entering more than one Vocal group in a Class, please note:**

Each individual member of a vocal group may appear only **TWICE** in any one Class.

Each vocal group within a Class must not have more than HALF the same individual members.

**Accompaniment for Vocal Section:**

Solos/Duets may be accompanied by one instrument in addition to, or instead of, a piano.

Small groups may be accompanied by up to two additional instruments (and/or piano).

Choirs (over 8 singers) may use up to four additional instruments (and/or piano).

**Backing Tracks** MAY be used for Popular/Light Entertainment solo, duet and group items in appropriate classes. They must NOT include ANY vocals. Backing Tracks should **not** be used in Own Selection classes, Folk Song Classes or the Recital classes except for 12 & 13 years Light Entertainment. **PLEASE GIVE ADVANCE NOTICE THAT YOU WILL BE USING BACKING TRACKS. THEY WILL NEED TO BE EMAILED IN TO OUR TECHNICIAN.**

**Junior Section Regional Awards** for outstanding performance by a local singer.

**\$50 Senior Award with miniature. \$25 Junior Award with miniature.**

(awards kindly sponsored by the Clevedon Valley Music Foundation Trust). The adjudicator will have a list of those competitors who are resident in: The former Franklin, Papakura & Manurewa Districts, Ardmore/Clevedon (including wider rural area) but excluding all other areas of the former Manukau City.

**Vocal Section Tuition Grants:**

There are two tuition grants available for the Adult Vocal Section and we thank Delia and Phil Cook and Stockman General Contractors Ltd for their support of these. The first two of these grants will be awarded to a person aged between 18 and 25 years who is in full time study at a recognized tertiary institution or who is receiving private music tuition. The grants are awarded



to the competitor with the highest mark in each class (below) who meets this criteria. *This may, therefore, not necessarily be the winner.* These grants are in addition to the prize money listed.

(1) \$300 Adult Recital Class 1 and \$200 for Oratorio Solo Class 3. (P & D Cook)

(2) \$300 for the Operatic Solo - Class 2. (Stockman General Contractors)

**Folk / Traditional Song** – Generally music/text will be handed down by oral tradition. This may be arranged, and it is permissible to use text with a known author that has been set to a traditional melody.

**Own Selection Classes** – Not an action song (gesture only). No costume.

**Restricted** – Open to competitors who have not received a First Placing for solo voice in THIS FESTIVAL or ANY OTHER Performing Arts Competition at the time of entry **AT ANY AGE**. No costume.

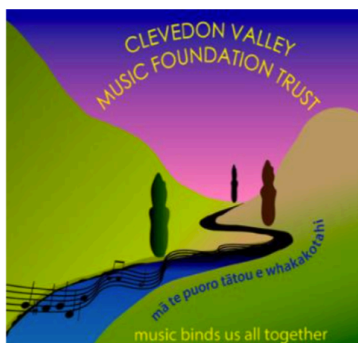

- Please advise us if you are withdrawing from the Nomination Award for any reason.*
- Entry fees for the Nomination Award are not refundable.*

## NATIONAL YOUNG PERFORMER AWARDS 2023 CRITERIA FOR MUSICAL THEATRE

- A. Competitors shall be 15 and under 21 years of age as at 1<sup>st</sup> October 2023
- B. Each competitor shall perform the following during the preliminary round:
1. Each competitor performs from memory, a programme of 2 stand alone/independent contrasting pieces- maximum of 7 minutes each- from fully staged Musicals and NOT from TV adaptations. The two pieces must NOT be from the same Musical.
  2. The programming MUST include at least one example of scene into song.
  3. The spoken excerpt of the scene into song, can be taken either from the original published musical theatre work OR devised by the competitor and should develop character and story.
  4. The programme should feature the integration of acting, singing and movement/dance and competitors must perform all three.
  5. Props are permitted but they must be handheld and not require any assistance.
  6. A backing track must be provided and will include music and silence as required for the full performance
  7. A penalty of 5 marks will be imposed if the time limit is exceeded by 30 seconds or more.
  8. Masterclass - Will be run by the Adjudicator. No audience observation.
- C. There will be a semi final of up to six competitors who will repeat the programme portion selected by the Adjudicator. Competitors will be chosen based on marks in the Preliminary round(s)
- D. For the Final Awards Concert three competitors will be recalled and shall repeat the remaining part of their programme.

*NB: Males can sing female roles and vice-versa. No distinction between genders.*

*Nomination of competitors by Societies should be based on classes B1 -B7 i.e. with or without the Master Class*

### SOCIETY NOMINATION

Each Society, which is a financial member of PACANZ, may nominate up to two competitors, who shall be selected by the adjudicator, based on a performance as outlined in A-D (above).

The adjudicator will determine that a competitor has displayed a sufficient standard of performance to competently represent that society at the National Young Performer Awards.

The standard required will be at the absolute discretion of the adjudicator but will include;

- A demonstration of adequate preparation and an authority of performance
- A performance with a level of maturity commensurate with a national final competition of this age group. If the adjudicator considers that sufficient standard has NOT been reached by any competitor, then NO nomination will be made.  
The Nominating Society is responsible for paying part of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards, which is \$75.00 incl gst.  
The Nominee is responsible for paying their portion of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards, which is \$175.00 incl gst.

### DIRECT NOMINATION:

Via a Competition Society Member

If the adjudicator considers that more than two competitors have reached a sufficient standard, the adjudicator may report to the committee that those competitors should be given the option of a DIRECT NOMINATION.

Via a Tertiary Institution Member

Nominations may also be put forward if Musical Theatre students have reached a sufficient standard and can meet the Criteria listed above.

The DIRECT NOMINATION competitor will be responsible for paying the full entry fee, which is \$250.00 incl gst.
