Welcome to the 62nd annual SAPACS Festival! If this will be your first Festival with us, then we are especially looking forward to hearing you sing. We would ask that you take careful note of the following "Competition Protocols" and "General Rules".

Door Entry:

\$15 for venue hire and ancillary expenses is compulsory on your entry form. This covers the competitor and one support person for one section.

The Anglican Church venue will have set door charges starting at \$2.

\$25 Friends Pass covers all sections and can be selected on your entry form.

Age: Will be taken as at 25 June 2026.

Time Limit: 4 minutes unless stated otherwise. Operatic and Oratorio Classes must not exceed 8 minutes.

Recording:

Generally, a competitor may arrange for his or her performance to be recorded by an audience member. You are reminded that IN NO CIRCUMSTANCES may you record, on any device, another performer without their permission. Flash photography is not allowed DURING an item. Please use tripods with consideration for the audience and note that the adjudicator's view must not be obscured. Adjudicator's comments are not to be recorded.

Challenge Trophies & Points: Competitors MUST COMPETE in ALL Classes specified for overall awards.

Prizes:

11 Years & Under and Restricted - Medals

12 years and over - First \$12.00, Second \$10.00, Third \$8.00 unless otherwise stated.

16 & 17 Years Championship Classes have special prize money of:

1st \$25, 2nd \$15, 3rd \$10.

Adult, Recital & Duet prize money as shown in the programme.

Any additional awards and donated prizes will be advised verbally.

Programme: There is no charge for a printed programme on your entry form, as each section's timetable will be available, free of charge, as a pdf download at www.sapacs.nz. Please check online from about 5 weeks prior to your section and contact lynda@sapacs.nz or phone 027 922 9748 if you need to know more urgently when you are likely to perform.

Entries: The Executive reserves the right to combine or cancel any classes where insufficient numbers of entries are received. Classes may have been divided where there are large numbers of entries.

Missing or Changing Information: Please contact Lynda if you need to change or add any information about your performances once entered.

Printed Music/Points Penalties:

A good quality photocopy (or original) **MUST** be provided for the Adjudicator. The top right hand corner is to show Competitor's name, Class and Number in that Class. **DO NOT RELY ON A PHOTOCOPIER BEING AVAILABLE AT THE VENUE. PLEASE BRING YOUR ADJUDICATOR'S COPY WITH YOU.** *There are some businesses with copying services - and the Papakura Library - within walking distance of the Church venue - please plan ahead!*

There will be a penalty of 3 points applied for a change of title once the Programme has been placed online. The same penalty will be applied for exceeding the stated time limit by more than ten seconds at the festival. The deduction will be shown clearly on all Report Sheets e.g. 82 - 3 = 79. Please also note that the bell may be rung if the item is excessively long.

Please ensure that you own or have access to original published/legal editions for all songs performed. It is up to teachers/competitors to prove ownership if requested. It is not essential to bring original music to the festival. Any music used by singers on stage (e.g. Oratorio / Choir music) **MUST** be a published/legal edition.

Accompanying:

Each studio or competitor is asked to organize their own accompanist. If you are in need of help, or can offer yourself or your accompanist as a help to others, please contact Lynda. **Currently advised as accepting referrals are Elizabeth Lau 021 628313 and Wendy Wei Huang 021 627028.**

Restricted Classes – Own Selection

Restricted Classes are open to competitors who **have not received a First Placing for solo voice in THIS FESTIVAL or ANY OTHER Performing Arts Competition** at the time of entry, regardless of age. e.g. if you won a 1st prize at age 8 and are now 15, you are **not** eligible to compete in **any** restricted class.

Duet and Group Classes:

- Ribbons will be awarded to each member of a vocal group who is placed.
- Duet classes are to be entered in age group of older competitor.
- A competitor may enter a duet class twice provided it is with a different partner each time.

Choirs/Vocal Groups please note: Marks will not be lost for using printed music, but extra marks may be awarded for overall presentation.

If entering more than one Vocal group in a Class, please note:

Each individual member of a vocal group may appear only **TWICE** in any one Class. Each vocal group within a Class must not have more than HALF the same individual members.

Accompaniment for Vocal Section:

Solos/Duets may be accompanied by one instrument in addition to, or instead of, a piano.

Small groups may be accompanied by up to two additional instruments (and/or piano). Choirs (over 8 singers) may use up to four additional instruments (and/or piano).

Backing Tracks MAY be used for Popular/Light Entertainment/Character in Costume items in appropriate classes. They must NOT include ANY vocals. Backing Tracks should **not** be used in Own Selection classes, Folk Song Classes or the Recital classes.

Please give advance notice that you will be using backing tracks, as they may need to be emailed in to our technician.

Junior Section Regional Awards for outstanding performances by a local singer.

\$50 Senior Award with miniature. \$25 Junior Award with miniature.

(Awards kindly sponsored by the Clevedon Valley Music Foundation Trust). The adjudicator will have a list of those competitors who are resident in: The former Franklin, Papakura & Manurewa Districts, Ardmore/Clevedon (including wider rural area) but excluding all other areas of the former Manukau City.

Notes for change of venue for individual/duet items:

Please respect the church buildings and grounds. Do not touch or move anything that is not yours!

All items offered should be "family friendly" and therefore suitable to present in a church building.

Competitors MUST base themselves in the downstairs hall. The upstairs toilet, kitchen and reception area are solely for the use of SAPACS and Church staff and volunteers at all times.

**JUNIOR VOCAL SECTION
(Under 18 years as at 25 June 2026)**

CHALLENGE TROPHIES – To be eligible, competitors must enter and compete in all classes. Trophies are to be engraved and returned for the following year at least 6 weeks prior to the commencement of the next festival. The winners of most cups and trophies will also be presented with a miniature trophy which is retained by the winner.

Folk Song classes – Generally music/text will be handed down by oral tradition. This may be arranged, and it is permissible to use text with a known author that has been set to a traditional melody. If both words and melody are composed, this would not meet our criteria. Note that Traditional Spirituals (with an unknown composer) are permitted in the Folk Song classes.

Own Selection Solo Age & Group Classes – Not an action/movement song (gesture only). No costume.

Character in Costume: Song presented, and costume worn, must relate to the particular character.

All items to be sung from memory – except for Oratorio

Restricted Classes – Own Selection

Open to competitors who have not received a First Placing for solo voice in THIS FESTIVAL or ANY OTHER Performing Arts Competition at the time of entry, regardless of age. e.g. if you won a 1st prize at age 8 and are now 15, you are **not** eligible to compete in any restricted class.
